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A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, there are various military reservations under the control of the Secretary of War which comprise areas of historic and scientific interest;

AND WHEREAS, by section 2 of the Act of Congress approved June 8, 1906 (34 Stat. 225) the President is authorized "in his discretion, to declare by public proclamation historic landmarks, historic and prehistoric structures, and other objects of historic or scientific interest that are situated upon the lands owned or controlled by the Government of the United States to be national monuments, and may reserve as a part thereof parcels of land, the limits of which in all cases shall be confined to the smallest area compatible with the proper care and management of the objects to be protected";

NOW THEREFORE, I, Calvin Coolidge, President of the United States of America, under authority of the said Act of Congress do hereby declare and proclaim the hereinafter designated areas with the historic structures and objects thereto appertaining, and any other object or objects specifically designated, within the following military reservations to be national monuments:

FORT WOOD, NEW YORK

The site of the Statue of Liberty Enlightening the World, the foundations of which are built in the form of an eleven-pointed star and clearly define the area comprising about two and one-half acres.

CASTLE PINCKNEY, Charleston Harbor, South Carolina.

The entire reservation, comprising three and one-half acres situated on Shutes Folly Island at the mouth of Cooper River opposite the southern extremity of the city of Charleston and about one mile distant therefrom.

FORT PULASKI, GEORGIA

The entire area comprising the site of the old fortifications which are clearly defined by ditches and embankments, which inclose about twenty acres.

FORT MARION, FLORIDA

The entire area comprising 18.09 acres situated in the city of Saint Augustine, Florida.

FORT MATANZAS, FLORIDA

An area of one acre comprising within it the site of the old fortification which is situated on a marsh island south of the present main channel of the Matanzas River in the southeast quarter of section 14, Township 9 South, Range 30 East, about 15 miles from the city of Saint Augustine, and about one mile from Matanzas Inlet.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the seal of the United States to be affixed.

Done at the city of Washington this fifteenth day of October, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and
[SEAL.] twenty-four, and of the Independence of the United States of America the one hundred and forty-ninth.

Parents and Kids

Key findings



Online since birth

Four out of five (79%) parents post images, videos, or personal information about their kids online. And 39% say it's fine to start posting images of their kids as soon as they're born.



The infinite digital footprint

Nearly half (47%) of Gen Z feel that a harmful effect of the internet is that "anything you do follows you forever."



Clashing expectations for privacy

While 73% of Gen Z wish their parents would ask permission before posting pics about them online at least some of the time, only 34% of parents ask permission and 39% feel they don't need permission to post content related to their kids.



The dangers of the internet

96% of parents and 93% of Gen Z say that using the internet can have harmful effects, with cyberbullying (73% of parents, 66% of Gen Z) and being influenced by misinformation (65% of parents, 64% of Gen Z) as the top two.



Conflicting sense of reality

89% of parents say they monitor their child's activity, yet 66% of teenagers say their parents have no involvement in their online accounts.



Problematic security advice

A majority of Gen Z (70%) report that their parents taught them about password security in some way, including problematic security advice like: use the same password for everything (17%), make easy-to-remember passwords (30%), and write down passwords on paper (33%).



Lacking parental support

Three-quarters (74%) of parents are confident they are keeping their children safe online, but only 51% of Gen Z respondents agree with the statement: "I feel supported online by my parents."



Stealthy workarounds

72% of Gen Z admit to having tactics to avoid their parents' monitoring. Some kids even go above and beyond to avoid detection, with 13% using a virtual private network (VPN), 9% having a secret device parents don't know about, and 6% performing factory resets on their devices.



Social media skepticism

72% of parents are glad they didn't have social media accounts when they were growing up and 35% of Gen Z wish they had waited until they were older to start using it.

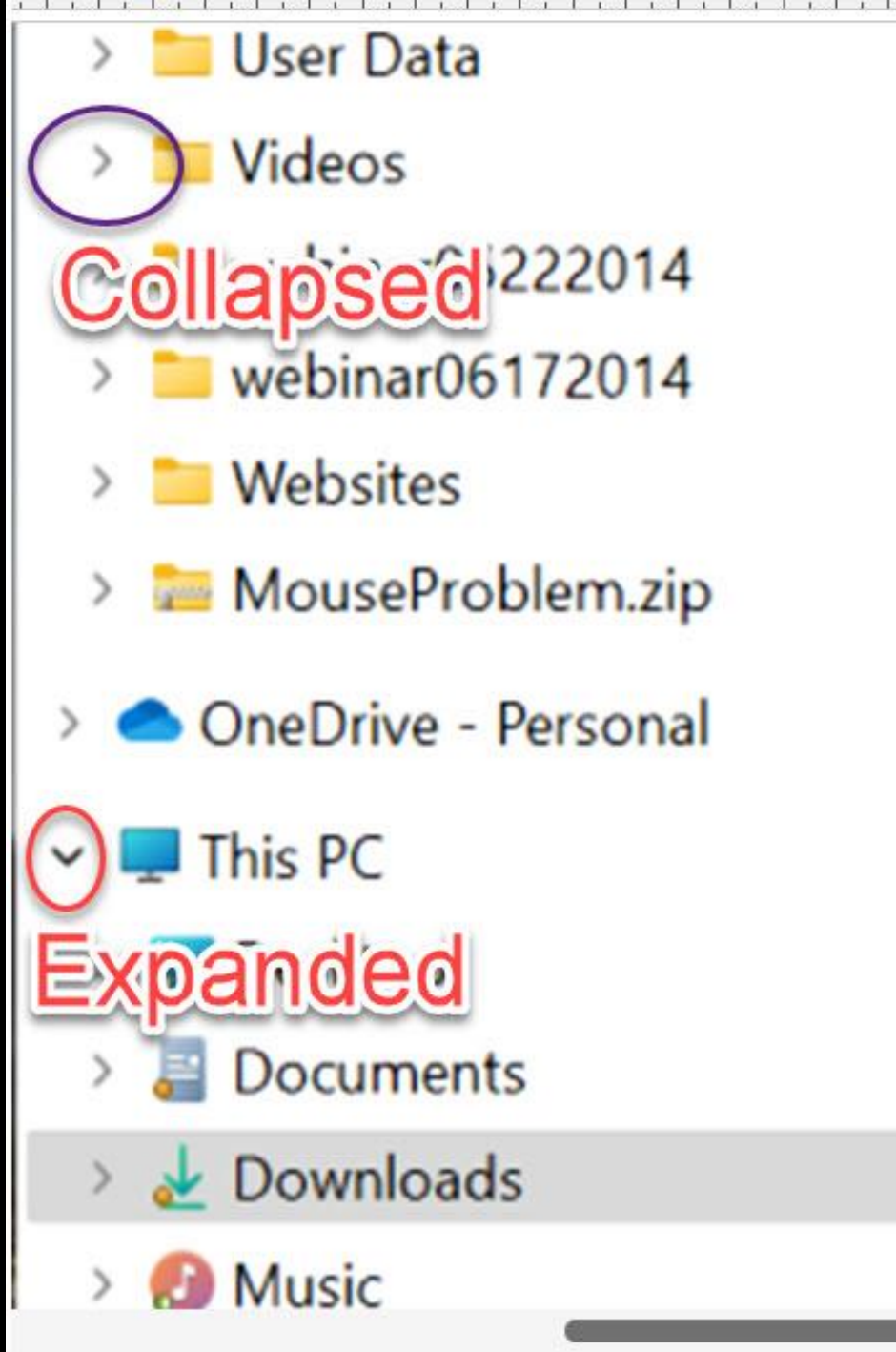

CommonSpirit confirms ransomware attack as U.S. hospitals deal with fallout

CommonSpirit Health — one of the largest nonprofit health care systems in the U.S. — confirmed on Wednesday evening that it was hit with a ransomware attack that [caused widespread IT outages at hospitals across the country](#) over the last week.

A spokesperson for the organization told The Record that after the ransomware attack was discovered, CommonSpirit staffers contacted law enforcement and hired cybersecurity specialists to deal with the response and contain the incident.

Last week, CommonSpirit Health announced that it was “managing an IT security issue” impacting several electronic health record systems across the country. Several facilities among the organization’s more than 1,000 care sites and 140 hospitals in 21 states reported widespread outages and issues with computer systems.

Employees at hospitals have turned to social media and [news outlets](#) as the problems cascaded over the last week.

One anonymous nurse [took to Reddit](#) to harshly criticize the organization for its response to the crisis, calling it a “nightmare” and corroborating other reports that dozens of hospitals now have to use paper charts that were not standardized.

Patient history is difficult to access for several facilities and pharmacies are reportedly unable to verify orders or print official labels. Some hospitals now have to use fax machines to share prescriptions. Employees are getting more information about the incident from the media than from CommonSpirit, according to the post.
