


FREE WEBINAR


## **Question of the Week**

### Answer:

One of the major reasons for a lot of pop-ups is browser extensions. Take a look at this photo:



Of the three extensions listed, if you logged into us for Remote Technical Support (<u>www.4kcc.com/rts</u>), we would remove Package Tracker and Search Encrypt as they want to change your search engine and they can be the source of unwanted pop-ups and, perhaps, even page re-directs.
