Dear Valued Customer,

### Please be careful what you mark Spam/Junk.

Last week, two of our long-time customers accidentally allowed our email to be marked "spam" and they were automatically removed from our mailing list. We had to call them to get them back on.

There are several ways our emails get marked as spam. First, you can actually go to the bottom of our emails and mark us spam. Please don't do that - if you no longer want our emails, just unsubscribe. (This is not a good idea for Remote Technical Support customers as you won't get notices for the Quarterly Checkups.)

Another way our emails get marked spam is that the ISP puts them in your Spam/Junk folder and you don't check that folder. If you check it and find our email there, please mark it "NOT JUNK/SPAM." If you allow it to sit in the Spam/Junk folder, it will be reported as Spam and you'll be automatically taken off our mailing list. Robly, the company we use to send our mass emails, has very strict rules about how many spam emails we can have. So, please be sure to check your Spam/Junk folder.
