Next Seminar

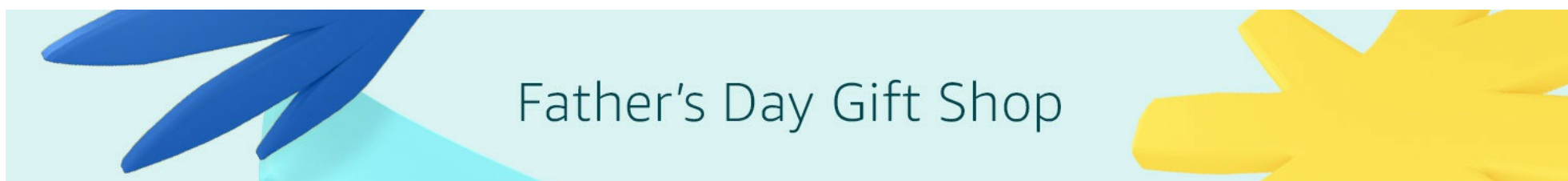
