Setup is \$104.95 when you purchase from us.






Next Seminar

Question of the Week



For this week, I'm going to answer 5 questions instead of just one! Enjoy!

Question 1:

"I read in your blog about Yahoo disposable email addresses. Are there other services that offer throwaway email addresses?

Answer 1:

Question 2:

"When is the new version of Windows 10 coming out? Wasn't it due in April?"

Answer 2:

Yes, it was due in April but it was delayed while Microsoft fixed some issues. However, the latest version of Windows 10 - version 1903 is out now! We've already installed it on several of our machines. Microsoft will begin pushing it out to computers currently in use this week. Also later this week, we'll be blogging about some of the new features in this version of Windows 10. Be sure to sign up for our blog email by clicking **HERE**.

Question 3:

"I understand that support for Windows 7 ends in just 7 months. Can't I just upgrade my computer to Windows 10 instead of having to purchase a new computer?"

Answer 3:

If your Windows 7 computer is three (3) years old or older, I don't recommend you upgrade it. First, most statistical reports on computer lifespan agree that laptops generally last about 3 1/2 years while desktops and all-in-ones hold on for about 5 years. With this in mind, I always caution people to not sink more than \$50 into a computer that is close to those lifespan numbers. Plus, a computer that is 3+ years old doesn't have the newest processor and memory types which are manufactured with Windows 10 in mind. So, even if it was worth upgrading, you'd probably be unhappy with the computer's speed and performance as upgrading will most likely slow it down considerably. In my book, it's just not sensible to consider upgrading a Windows 7 machine that is 3 years old or older. Don't forget, we always have great deals on new computers so be sure to check with us before you buy (like the one featured above).

Question 4:

"Is there a new version of Mac OS for computers?"

Answer 4:

Generally, Apple announces new versions of the Mac OS in June. This year, we expect them to announce Mac OS 10.15. We don't know it's name yet and Apple isn't telling us much about it. However, we do know that Apple is working towards cross-platform apps. In other words, an app you can put on your iPhone or iPad will also work on your iMac. Look for more information sometime in June after Apple makes its announcement.

Question 5:

"My Vipre anti-virus subscription is almost up. Are you still recommending Vipre? Should I renew it?"

Answer 5:

We continue to recommend Vipre. We still feel it is the best anti-virus available. Of course, we continue to test other anti-virus software but Vipre still is at the top of our list. The good news for Mac computer owners is that Vipre is now available for your device. If you don't use Vipre, please consider changing over when your current anti-virus software subscription is up.
