Question:

"My wireless keyboard skips letters/numbers when I'm typing. What is wrong?"

Answer:


The first thing to realize is that wireless keyboards (and a wireless mouse) run on batteries. Whenever you start to have a problem with a wireless keyboard or mouse, the first thing to do is install new batteries. How you do that varies with each keyboard/mouse model. Hopefully, you remember how to change them or you kept the instructions!

If you install new batteries and the keyboard still skips letters/numbers, the next thing to do is to plug in a wired keyboard or try another wireless keyboard, if you have one available. (If you don't have another keyboard, perhaps you can borrow one from a neighbor, relative or friend.) If the substitute keyboard works without skipping letters or numbers, the electronics in your keyboard has gone bad. Time to get a new wireless keyboard (or keyboard and mouse combination) and get back to typing without skipping. On the other hand, if if the temporary keyboard does the same thing, then it might be the controller in the computer (very rare that this happens). If that's the case, you will need us to check it out.

Interestingly, I actually just went through this with my desktop computer in the shop. It kept skipping letters and numbers and, when battery replacement didn't fix it, I installed a new keyboard and mouse combo. All is well now!
